I am pleased that I have been able to welcome all our classes back to school this week.

### COVID-19 Update

Whilst we all continue to find ourselves in uncertain times, it is important that everyone does their bit to reduce the risk of spreading Covid-19, especially as we have now entered a second period of partial lockdown.

The children and staff work hard to follow the school's systems and procedures:

- Ensuring that washing of hands takes place regularly
- Children are constantly reminded about personal hygiene including
  - Washing of hands
  - Using hand sanitiser when coming into school from outside
  - The slogan 'Catch it, Bin it, Kill it' to avoid spreading any illness
- Surfaces and door handles/plates are cleaned regularly throughout the day

In addition to the measures we have put in place in school, it is important that we have the support from parents/carers too.

Please may I ask parents and carers to:

- Keep your child off school if:
  - Your child or anyone in your household has COVID-19 symptoms
  - Anyone in your household has been for a test (and is still awaiting results)
  - Your child or anyone in your household tests positive for COVID-19
- Wear a face covering when they enter the school premises through the gates
- Adhere to social distancing guidance when waiting outside at the beginning and end of the school day
- Have only ONE adult family member come onto the school premises at the beginning and end of the school day
- Follow the one way system down the side of school (next to the railway line)
- Ensure your child has a jumper/cardigan or school fleece in school.

Although the school continues to be heated, windows and skylights are open to allow for adequate ventilation

During our recent partial closure before the holiday, staff provided remote learning for the children using Class Dojo. I was really impressed with the level of engagement from children and enjoyed watching some of the videos that were posted.

As well as being able to share work for the children, Class Dojo is an online platform that can be used as a way of communicating between staff and parents. It is also used as a reward system in school and allows you to see when your child has been given an award and what for.

## Assemblies

Whilst it continues to be a disappointment that parents can't join us on a Friday for assemblies we are continuing to celebrate the children's achievements in school.

The whole school will take part in our Well Done assemblies via Zoom. This half term we are also holding Celebration assemblies for each bubble in the hall.
