NSPCC workshops: Speak out Stay Safe.

Last week, children in Year 5 and Year 2 had workshops from the NSPCC with the theme and message of; Speak out, Stay Safe. They met Buddy, who is a soft toy mascot shaped like a speech bubble who encourages the children to speak out if they have any worries or concerns. The children learnt about different types of hurt which were explained in an age appropriate way. They discussed who their trusted adults are and how important they are.
