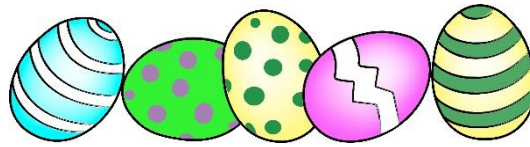




All Saints C.E Primary School Easter 2022 Newsletter

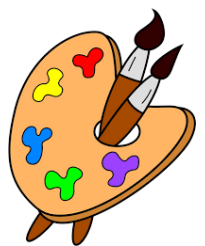
