Class 1 Programme of Work



Parents:

This overview of the Year 1 curriculum during the Summer Term is to give you information that will help you to play an active role in your child's education.

For example, you might be able to help them to research topics on the internet, at the library or even plan trips out to relevant places of interest.

We plan using topics

Our topic for this half term is "the Rainforest" and for the second half term it is Pirates. The children's learning will be based around the key questions "What did Bob Bear see on his holiday in the Rainforest?" and "Ahoy Me Hearties. Do You Want to Go On An Adventure?"

English

The children will cover a number of genres this term based on the writing scheme The Big Writing Adventure.

Fiction

The children will read and discuss fictional texts traditional stories islands but predominantly pirate themed stories.

They will explore the characters and settings of these texts and delve into the events in them. They will rewrite the story of Little Red Riding Hood, write a newspaper paper for the wolf's side of the story.

Non-fiction

We will be exploring information texts with a focus on 'The Rainforest'. The children will have experience of reading a range of information texts where they will explore their purpose and features.

They will then go on to develop their knowledge of information texts by planning, researching and writing their own information texts based around the Rainforest.

Poetry

This term, the children will explore poetry which focuses on rhyming words and will write a poem based on a theme.

Phonics

Phonics is taught through the scheme Read, Write Inc. The children are grouped into colour bands based on assessments carried out each half term.

The children will be encouraged to apply previously learnt sounds in their reading and writing.

Mathematics

Below is a list of some of the mathematical concepts we will be focussing on this term.
Counting in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s to 100
Recalling addition and subtraction bonds to 20
Solve problems involving counting, adding, subtracting, doubling or halving in the context of numbers.

To start to understand multiplying and dividing
Recognising and making whole, half and quarter turns.

Please continue to encourage your child to practise their number bonds to 20 and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s to 100 at home.

Science

Exploring the properties of objects

Sorting objects based on their properties

Identifying materials and their properties

Identifying parts of a plant

Growing plants

Finding out what plants need to be able to grow through investigations on the differences between plants grown in the light and in the dark; suggesting how to find out about what plants need in order to grow well

Computing

ICT will be integrated across the whole curriculum. The children will have opportunity to carry out activities on the computer and iPads. Here are some examples of the types of activities the children will be doing:

Programming a computerised robot to reach a final destination

Word processing information about the Rainforest

Geography

Identifying features of islands

Identify features of a treasure island

Creating a treasure map using coordinates

Identify a place based on its features using sources

Locate the rainforests on a world map and identify names of countries

Know that the rainforest is a habitat to a variety of animals

Know that the rainforest is made up of different layers

Design Technology

Explore images of pirate ships and their designs

Design a pirate ship

Select appropriate materials

Construct a model of a pirate ship based on the designs and materials selected

Evaluate designs

Art

Identify features used by Monet in his artwork

Use a range of materials to create pieces of artwork in the style of Monet

Physical Education

Catching and throwing whilst moving
